TRAINING TO PERSONS ENGAGED IN TRANSLATION WORK .

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:-

(a) whether Government have any scheme for imparting intensive training to the persons engaged in translation work in various offices so that they may perform their duty efficiently;

(b) the details of the said scheme;

(c) the number of such Central Government employees of his Ministry who are engaged in translation work at present and they have not got any kind of training in this regard; and

(d) by when they are likely to be imparted training in translation ?

ANSWER

(SHRI I.D. SWAMI)

(a) and (b): Yes Sir, Central Translation Bureau conducts the quarterly translation training programme in Delhi, Mumbai, Calcutta and Bangalore for imparting extensive translation training to the working translators and employees connected with the translation work in Central Govt. Offices.

(c)&(d): In addition to one Director and one Deputy Director, 5 Officers and 17 translators are engaged in translation work in the Ministry of Home Affairs(Proper). All the five officers have undergone training in translation from Central Translation Bureau. Similarly 5 translators out of 17, have undergone training in translation. Efforts will be made to train the remaining Translators turn by turn within the next two years.
